Packenham Water Mill

Mill Road, Pakenham, Bury St Edmunds. IP31 2NB

Packenham water mill is the last surviving water mill in Suffolk. It is a water powered mill, with an engine to back up the production in times of drought. The mill was working as an animal feed producer until its closure in 1974. The mill is now owned by the Suffolk Buildings Preservation Trust.
